KEY BENEFITS

INCREASE SITE RE-VISIT

Visitors come back frequently to edit or view their list. Customers can use the Saved Carts like a Wishlist to save items they want to order in the future. eSource Saved Carts enables visitors to save as many lists as they want, not just a single list like some websites.

USER CONVENIENCE

Sales representatives can benefit from the Saved Cart feature by allowing them to throw a Shopping Cart into suspension so that they can finish the order later. This is helpful when they need to get more information or are interrupted with another request and need to do something else before they complete the order.

MINIMIZE SHOPPING CART ABANDONMENT

The Saved Cart feature allows you to pick up where you left off since the last visit with no loss of items that were placed in the cart.

ADDITIONAL FEATURES

- Items commonly ordered together can be saved in a specific Saved List.
- Each user can save multiple Saved Lists.
- Saved Lists are named and defined by each user.
- Saved Lists can be edited by adding or deleting items, changing the quantities of items or changing the name of the list.
- Items contained in a user's shopping cart are saved for the next login.
- Customized messages for duplicate List names.
- Saved Carts created by Sales Representatives can be shared with customers. When a Saved Cart is shared, the customer can access the list but cannot edit.
- Saved Carts/Lists are stored in the database so that customers can access it from any computer, not just the one where the list was originally created.

The eSource Saved Cart module allows you to save shopping cart items to a Saved Cart that can be used on a later visit. It can also be used to reorder the same products repeatedly. Saved Carts are named with a description of your choice and a single customer can have as many saved carts as desired.

Saved Cart is also very useful on a Sales Portal to allow the saving of incomplete orders until further information is gathered or until you are able to complete the entry of the order. Another functionality of the Saved Cart module is to automatically save the current shopping cart in case the browser is accidentally closed before the order is completed. The user will be prompted to reload the shopping cart if desired when they visit the site again.

Main Features

Items are added to the shopping cart first and then saved as a List. Customers can then choose the Saved Cart/List menu item to display their saved Shopping Carts. The Saved Carts can be named, edited and used at anytime.
